1. Flashnotes

2. Lore

3. Interactive Whiteboards

This is a way in which the lessons get more interactive, the students are more interested in Whiteboards than in a regular board and it is believed that this technology is the future of the primary and secondary education.

4. E-learning courses

This kind of learning is helpful for the students that have to be home schooled. This technology can also apply for bachelor or master degree students that cannot travel to another University from a foreign country. E-learning basically helps students to buy the courses from the internet, because every University provides them with online courses, and study by themselves at home and then get a degree at the end.
