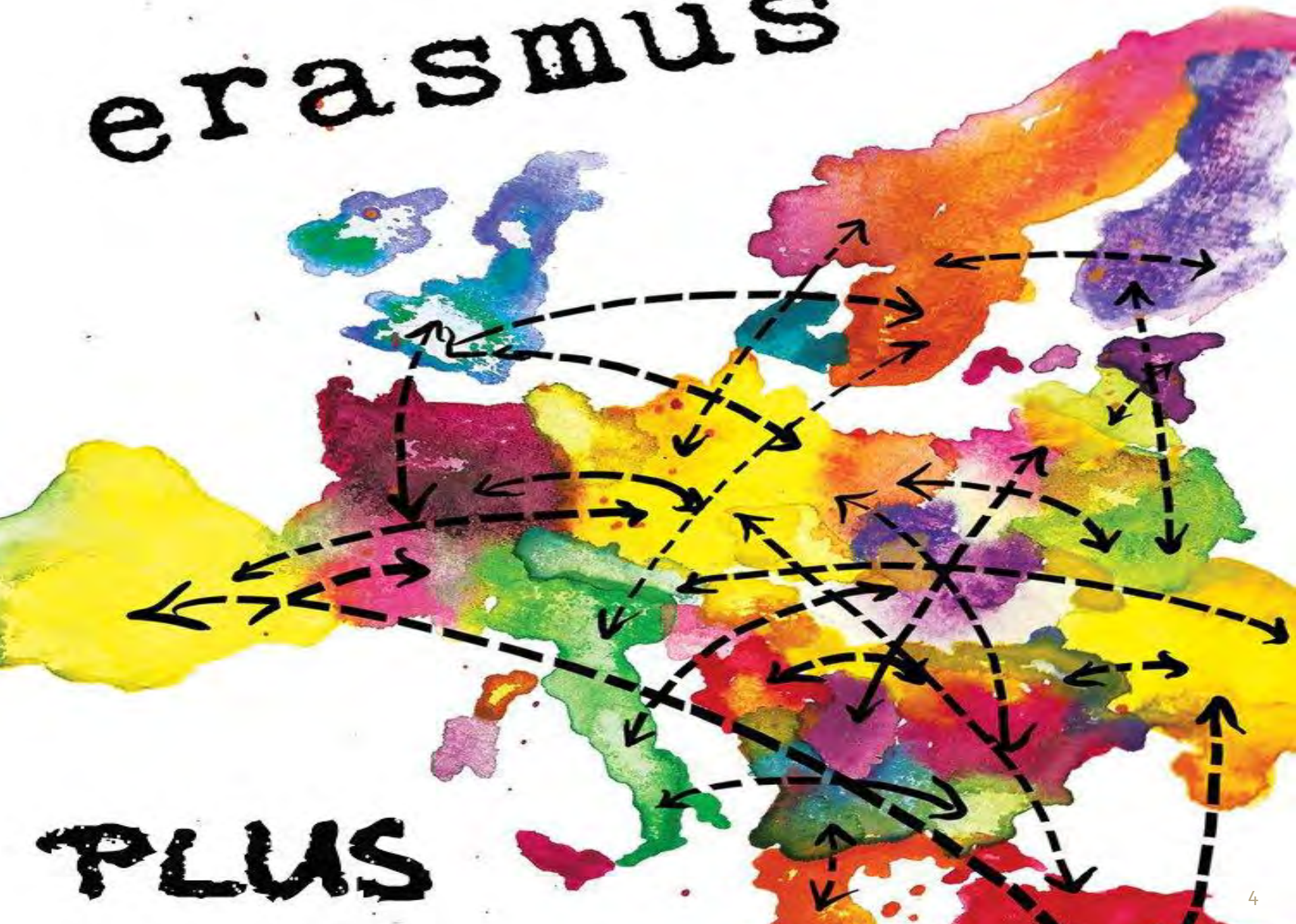

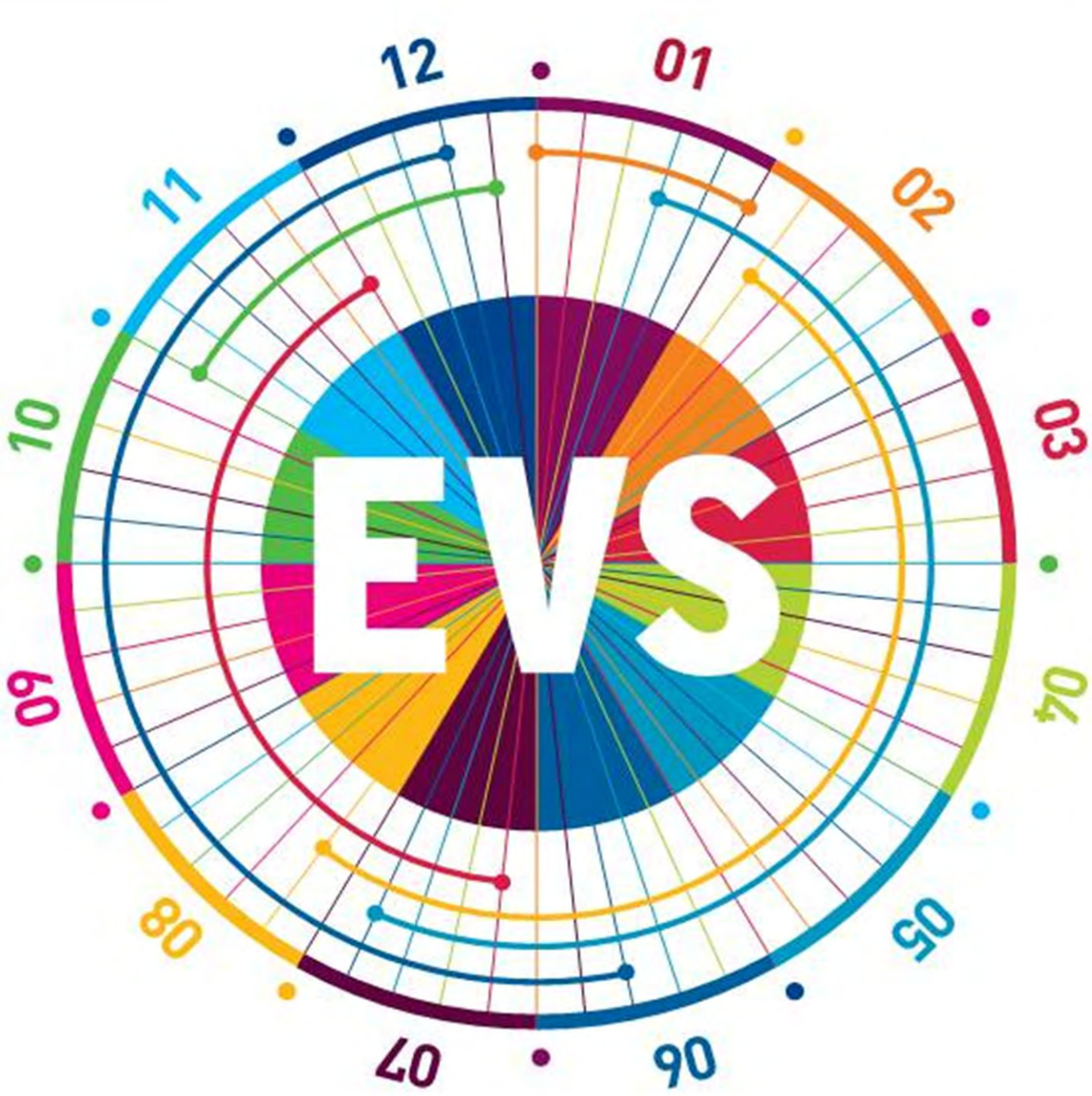

It is really important student to acquire knowledge and to use the content to teach core competencies. Think about which one works more for you and find a way to use it. Get the best of them and be the best version of yourself!

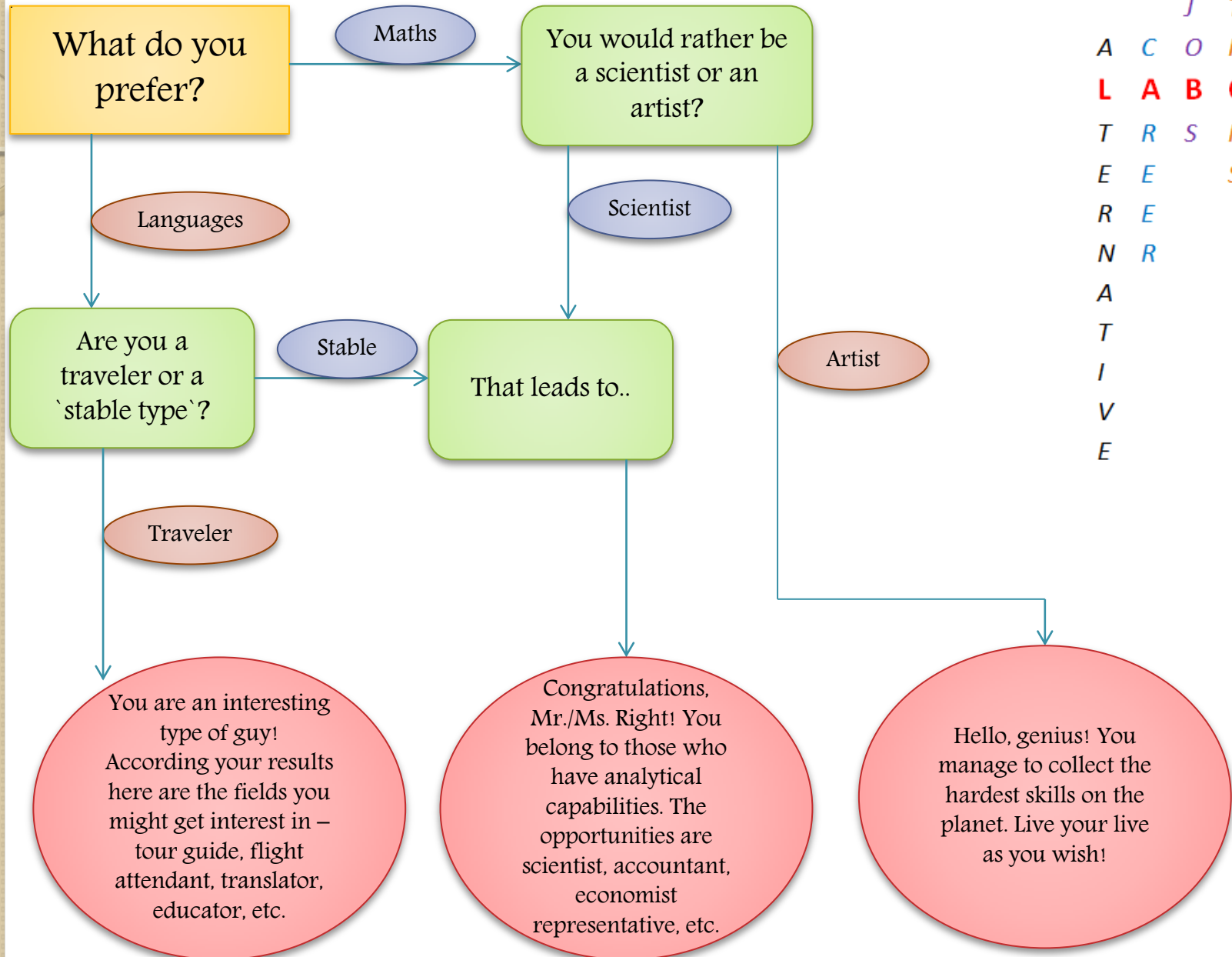
