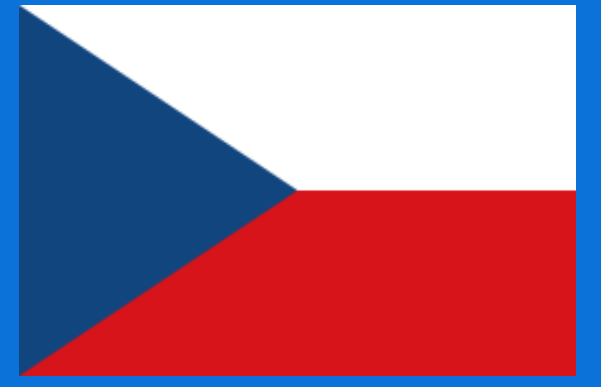

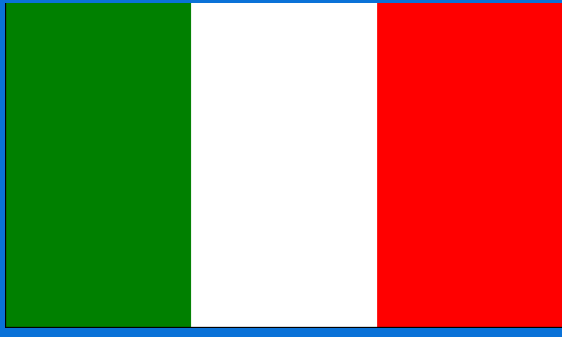

Cyprus

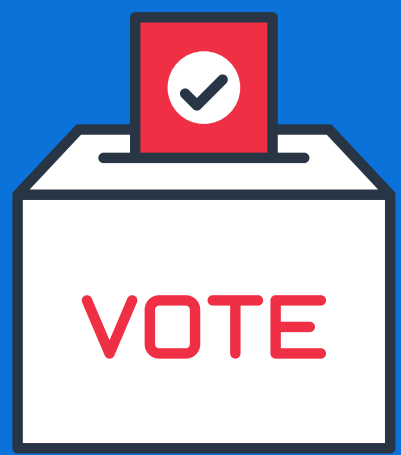

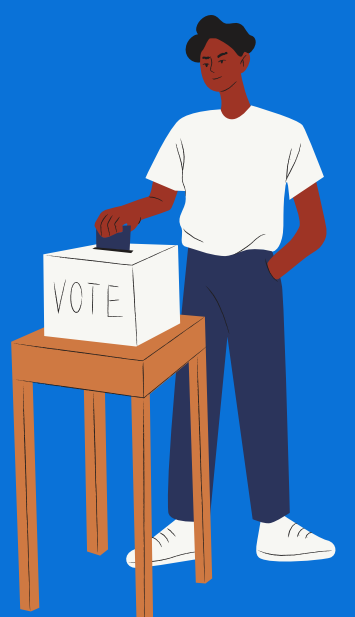
